



Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking (MSHT) Awareness Training

Overview

Hope for Justice is a national and global charity with a mission to bring an end to modern slavery by preventing exploitation, reaching victims, restoring lives, and reforming society. We now have a Lancashire Hub comprising of two Community Engagement Specialists and a Trainer and can currently offer free training to raise awareness in order to help identify, report and support cases of modern slavery and human trafficking within Lancashire communities.

Learning Outcomes

The training will provide a briefing for participants to provide them with an overview of modern slavery and human trafficking and will cover the basics of:

- What MSHT is and the different types that exist
- The signs and indicators of MSHT
- How to respond if a victim of MSHT is identified

Target Audience

The training is aimed at staff and volunteers who provide support to people through the Preston public health and community asset networks.

Delivery Methods

- The training will be delivered by Ruth Packwood (HfJ Trainer) over MS Teams
- Ruth will send the MS Teams invitation to Rosie Paterson who will then forward it onto the delegates attending the training
- Delivery will include an overview of the national and local facts and figures, case studies, a short video and trainer input on the subject
- A member of the HfJ Community Engagement Team will aim to be present during the training to answer any specific queries relating to vulnerable people or those at risk of exploitation
- Participants will be provided with an electronic copy of the HfJ Training Manual and other training support materials
- Participants will be asked to complete feedback at the end of the training
