

ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Thursday is the Solemnity of the Ascension and a Holy Day of Obligation. The occasion of Jesus leaving his disciples might be thought of as a moment of sadness. However, the Gospel for the day tells us that the disciples returned to Jerusalem with great joy. This is the fulfilment of Jesus' mission. The second reading makes this clear by using the image of Christ entering into the heavenly temple, having made his offering once for all on the cross. We are called to "enter the house of God" because Jesus has gone before us. This is a feast of hope.

In this Holy Year we are called to be "Pilgrims of Hope". The Ascension of the Lord points us to the destination of our




to take up that pilgrimage by carrying out the mission that Jesus has given them. The mission is that "repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations". They are to be his witnesses. It is in the ho

pilgrimage, to be with him in heaven. The disciples go back to Jerusalem

proclaimed in his name to all nations". They are to be his witnesses. It is in the hope of the resurrection that they go back to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. As part of the Church, through our baptism, we share that mission. We are to be witnesses to that hope in our world.

We live in a world where there is a great need for that hope. Many are without hope or purpose in their lives. Many situations in our world look hopeless. We have the message of hope. We have confidence that we can follow where Christ, our head, has gone before us. Thursday's feast is a time for renewing our own hope and to share the joy of the disciples. It is also a time to open ourselves to the Holy Spirit at work in us that we to may be witness to the hope which Christ brings.


