BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Today ten of our children will be making their first Holy Communion, one of whom is also being baptised. The Second Vatican Council tells us that the Eucharist is the source and summit of Christian life. This day is, therefore, very important for them and their families. Indeed, it is an important day for all of us as today we especially give thanks for this gift of the Body and Blood of Christ.

In the second reading St Paul gives us the earliest account of the institution of the Eucharist. This account of what Jesus did at the Last Supper is very close to what we have in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke. Jesus tells his disciples to do this in remembrance of him and this is what we do today. We repeat the words of Jesus and



the bread and wine we offer becomes the body and blood of Christ.

The first reading and Gospel present us with scenes which foreshadow the Eucharist. The first is the rather mysterious scene in which the priest Melchizedek offers bread and wine on behalf of Abraham, giving thanks to God for what God has done for Abraham. The word Eucharist means thanksgiving. The Gospel is the story of the feeding of the five thousand. In the Eucharist Christ feeds us with something much more wonderful than the loaves and fish, he feeds us with his very self.

Today is a chance for us to reflect on our own baptism and our own sharing in the body and blood of Christ, with all that it means to us. It is a time to give thanks in wonder at the gift we have received. It is also a time to pray that the self-giving of Christ shown in the Eucharist might be reflected in our own lives.

Any vehicles in the courtyard are booked in and authorised since they are carrying out maintenance or other work for the parish.


